



Site rules: motorists (staff, students and visitors in motorised vehicles) on campus

As this is a public area with a high level of people movement, you must:

1. Give priority to pedestrians, wheelchair users, cyclists and other non-motorised vehicles as well as following the Highway Code (the code of practice for all University sites),
2. Observe the campus speed limits and other University signs.
3. Be particularly careful when reversing.
4. Possess the appropriate parking permit and park only in designated parking bays. Only Blue Badge Holders may park in disabled parking bays.
5. *Not* park where pavements, drop kerbs or access may be obstructed (these help wheelchair users and people who are blind, visually impaired or have mobility difficulties to move around campus safely),
6. Follow any instructions given to you by Security Service staff,
7. Report any incidents, accidents and emergencies through Security on (0113 34) 32222.
